MT. BAKER ELEMENTS ZINE-MAKING WORKSHOPS


PHASE 1 | A series of pocket guides translating information legible to designers and urban planners to an accessible and distributable format to support local organizing efforts. Zines are inexpensive and easily deployable methods for sharing information.

PHASE 2 | Collaborating with youth artists at Franklin High School to teach graphic skills, representation methods, research skills, and low-cost zine-making techniques as part of the Pocket Guide series. Youth artists can support designers and planners in language translation, creating artwork, and creating independent material that supports the cultural and political life of Mt. Baker.



COST ESTIMATE |

Paper = \$16
Printing = \$300

100 booklets = \$316, excluding labor and equipment

A grant of \$5000 could cover the cost of materials and printing of 3 individual zines and compensation for researchers, makers, and workshop facilitators.
