How can Community ownership of land in the North Rainier Neighborood area support communities of color and low income residents to build resilience? Land and housing are the foundation of a community and central in the ability to build strong social networks. Networks depend upon the security of housing and the ability to build and retain wealth.



Puget Sound Regional Council cites Mt. Baker Station area as a community with an immediate risk of displacement.



Building community resilience into Transit Oriented Development (TOD)

A case study of Atlanta Land Trust Collaborative

• Focus on neighborhoods around the Atlanta Beltline project created in response to rising land prices around transit improvements to prevent displacement

• Utilizing Tax increment financing district take tax revenue generated by new development and a portion is contributed to the land trust

- Partner with multiple organizations

• Keep housing affordable for the life of the transit project



The Atlanta Beltline project is transforming a decommissioned rail line surrounding the city into a 33 mile trail network. Connects with MARTA, heavy rail commuter line. 22 miles of street car line are planned in the central city.

REMEMBERING + RESPECT

Development draws on the history of the space and neighborhood cultures

PERMENATLY AFFORDABLE RENTAL + HOME OWNERSHIP

Provide a variety of housing types and income levels though Community Land Trust

ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT WITHOUT DISPLACEMENT

Support current businesses + workers to remain in place + new business creation

CREATION OF GREENSPACE FOR GATHERING + FOOD PRODUCTION

Create central gathering spaces + cultivate a local food system

PRIORITIZE NON MOTORIZED CONNECTIONS

Connected trail network across the neighborhood + to adjacent neighborhoods
