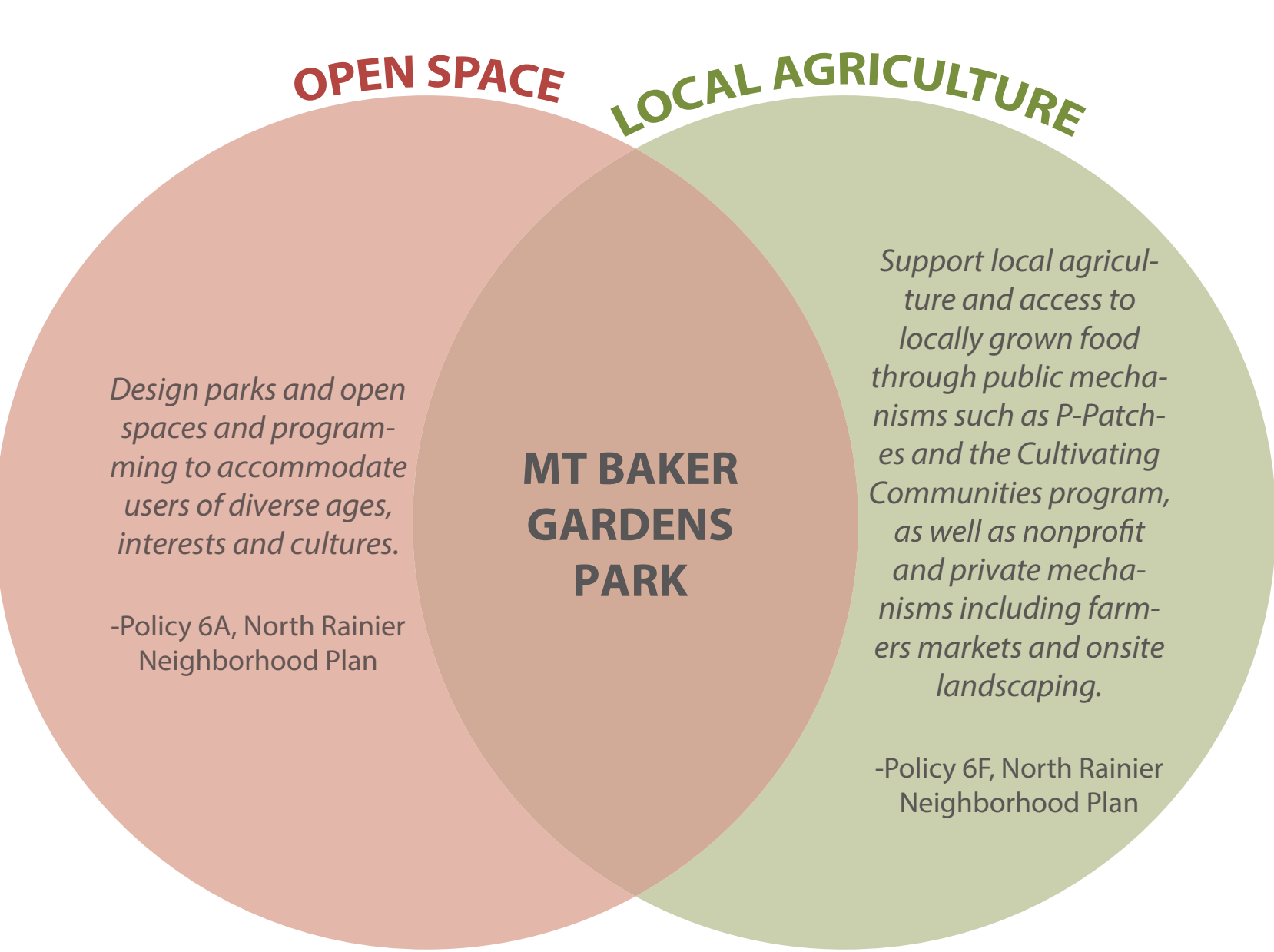


# CULTIVATING RESILIENCE IN MOUNT BAKER

## PROGRAMMING OPPORTUNITIES

- Partner with John Muir Elementary to develop a Children's Garden
- Partner with Franklin High School to develop a youth gardening program
- Partner with Green Plate Special to create a nutrition class for children
- Partner with Tilth Alliance to bring gardening classes to Mt Baker Gardens Park
- Promote intergenerational connections through a school/retirement home gardening program
- Partner with Dept. of Neighborhoods to develop a series of multicultural lunches/dinners in park
- Establish a seed swap
- Sponsor acoustic music events for youth and local musicians
- Promote art projects in the park, such as mosaics

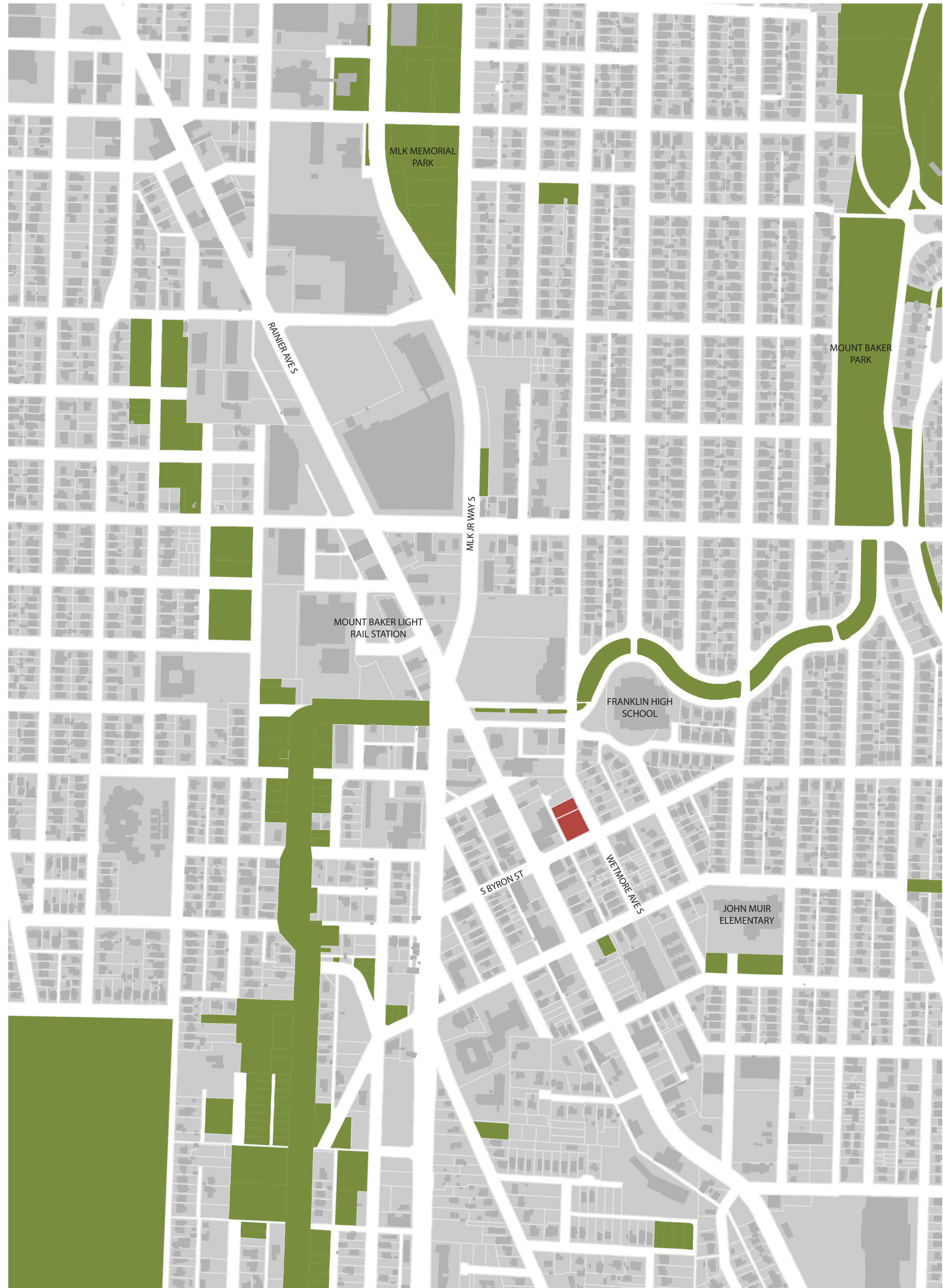

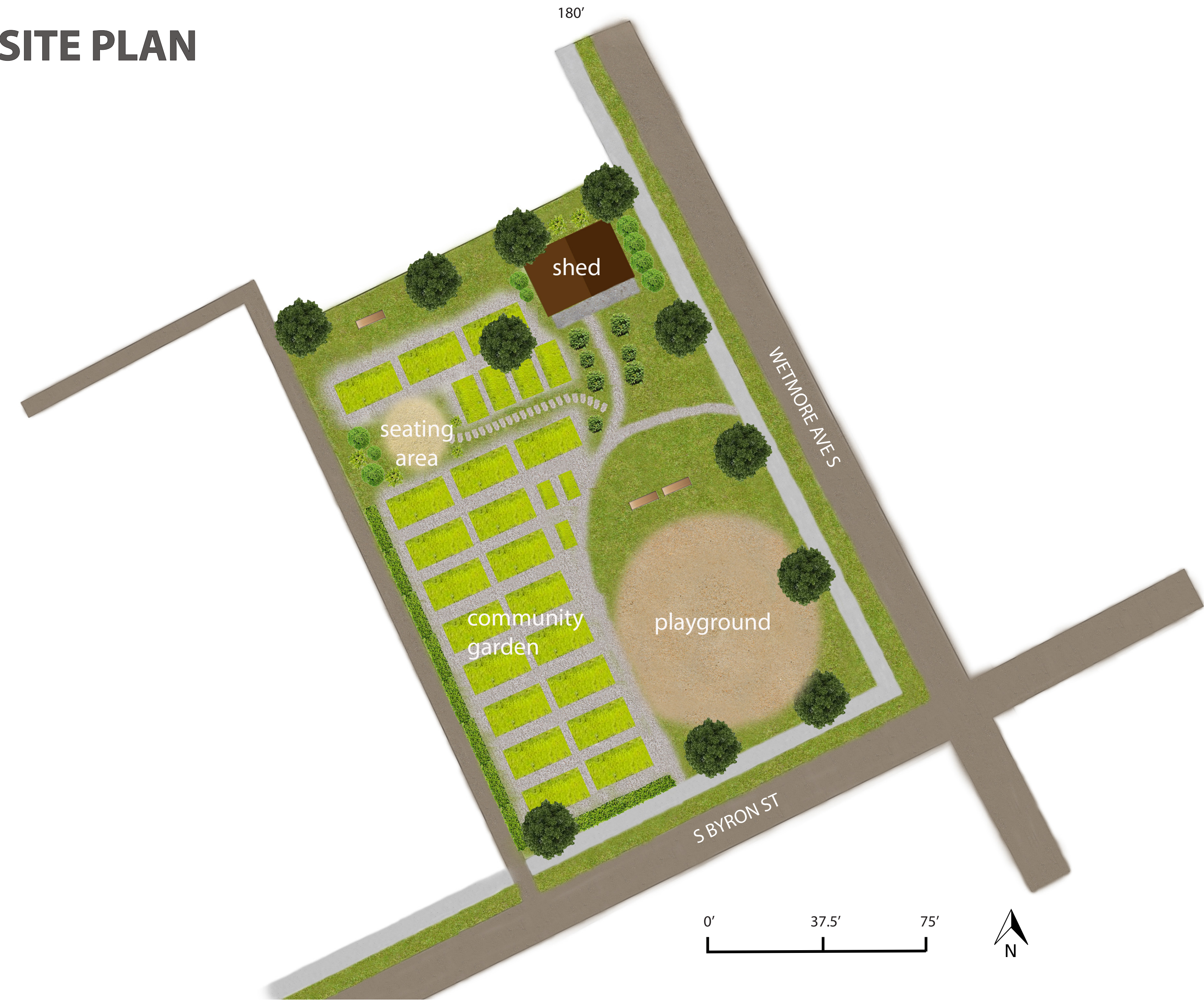

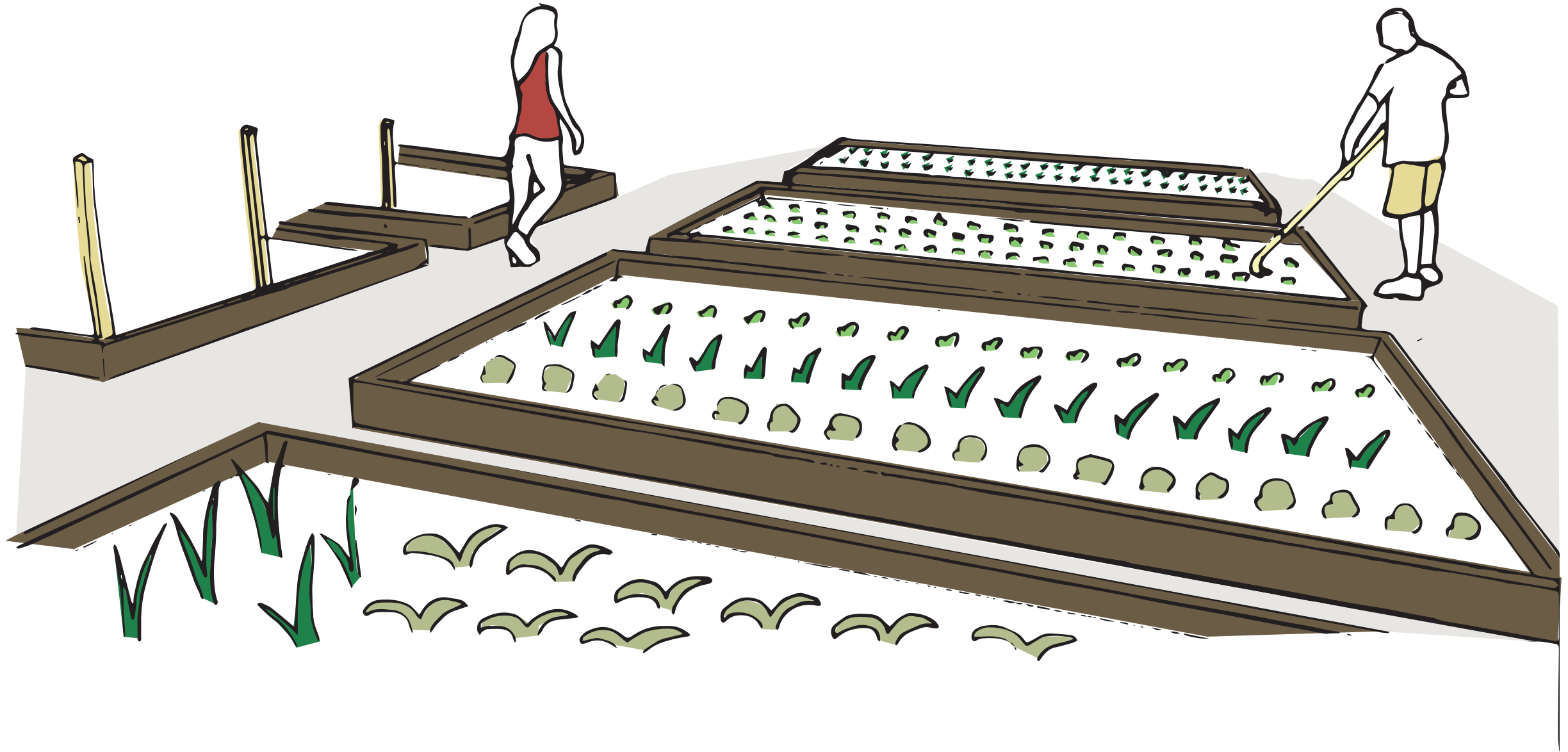
